



### "DOGS PLAYING POKER" ART

Dogs Playing Poker, by Cassius Marcellus Coolidge, refers collectively to an 1894 painting. A 1903 series of sixteen oil paintings commissioned by Brown & Bigelow was used to advertise cigars, and a 1910 painting. All eighteen paintings in the overall series feature anthropomorphized dogs, but the eleven in which dogs are seated around a card table have become well known in the United States as examples of kitsch art in home decoration. Depictions and reenactments of the series have appeared in many films, television shows, theater productions, and other popular culture art forms. The first painting, Coolidge's 1894 Poker Game, sold for \$658,000 at a 2015 auction.

Some dogs love workouts and are not easy to subdue. They do whatever they want and make plenty of noise yet are so friendly and sweet that they love to do tricks to entertain you when you come home. They are good guardians of the home.

More pets are lost on the Fourth of July than any other day of the year

July 5th is the busiest day of the year for shelters, which may be why the month of June was dubbed National Pet Microchip Awareness Month. When animals get spooked, their fight-or-flight response often takes over and they flee and get lost. Consider these recommendations:

- Keep your pet indoors on the Fourth of July. If you absolutely must bring your pet out with you, ensure he has an ID tag, his collar fits properly, and he is attached to a leash at all times.
- Get your pet micro-chipped. This can be scheduled as a quick outpatient appointment with your veterinarian.
- Take a photo of your pet, which will help your community identify him should he be lost and found.

Summer Heat

Almost everyone is good at looking after our dogs and cats in this hot weather, but what about our smaller fluffies like rabbits/guinea pigs/hampsters? To help them in their cages, hutches or coops, freeze a small bottle of water and lay it where they can get to it. They'll be able to sit close to it and will cool themselves. They'll also be able to lick the condensation from the sides – a bonus! It's such a simple idea and it could save a little life!

Why are sheep afraid of moving water?

Only a shepherd knows about the fears that sheep possess of running water. They will die from thirst before drinking from a fast moving stream. Sheep have reason to fear the running water because they cannot swim very well. Thrown into a deep, fast moving river, a sheep will probably not survive.



# PET-FRIENDLY 4TH OF JULY TIPS

**As we prepare for barbeques and fireworks this Fourth of July, here's a few tips on how to keep your pets safe and calm during this Independence Day.**

- It is safer to keep your pets at home during Fourth of July celebrations instead of bringing him to your neighbor's party. Keep your pets in the house, rather than in your yard. He will be a lot happier indoors, and not tempted to leap over a fence to find you.
- Dogs can be startled by the loud noise of fireworks. Once the festivities begin, keep your pet in a safe room where he can feel comfortable. If he is crate trained put him in his crate covered with a blanket to make him feel secure.
- Block outside sights and sounds by lowering the blinds and turning on the television. Play soothing music in the background to counteract the cacophony during the "rockets' red glare.
- If your pet seems overly anxious, spend some time with your pet, speaking soothingly to help them to relax.
- Avoid scraps from the grill. While tempting to our pets, any sudden change to your pets' diet can cause stomach upset. In addition, some certain foods like onions, avocado, grapes and raisins can be toxic .

Human products can be dangerous to animals . Avoid spraying your pet with insect repellent and only use special sunscreen that is intended for animal use. Keep your pets away from matches and lighter fluid. They can be extremely irritating to the stomach, lungs and central nervous system, if ingested.

Should your dog get scared, escape and run away, help find him with microchip identification. Collars and tags can fall off so make sure you have permanent ID with a microchip. Keep contact information current with your recovery service provider.




## Horse Books from the Past

The most well-known horse stories include *Black Beauty*, *National Velvet*, the *Black Stallion* series, *Misty of Chincoteague*, and *King of the Wind*, as well as contemporary favorites such as the *Saddle Club* series.


These novels have a long shelf life in libraries and online bookstores, and they have endeared generations of readers.

Regrettably, some of the best horse stories from the 1950s, 1960s, and 1970s have vanished from bookstores and libraries, unfortunately relegated to an "out-of-print" status that renders these titles obsolete. These treasured horse books, however, continue to have a special place in the hearts of horse-crazy bibliophiles all around the world. Let's take a trip down memory lane and reconnect ourselves with a few neglected classics that may still be obtained in used bookstores and on the internet.



### **Galloping Gold, by Patsey Gray**

As a prolific author of horse books, Patsey Gray is fondly remembered for her many titles, including *Double Standard*, *Jumping Jack*, *Star Lost*, *Horse in Her Heart*, and others. *Galloping Gold*, while possibly not her best-known book, is memorable for its heartwarming premise and the devotion and dedication that the book inspires. And who doesn't love a story that involves a gorgeous palomino horse?




### **Golden Sovereign, by Dorothy Lyons**

While Dorothy Lyons penned a dozen horse-related novels, her most widely known title is undoubtedly *Golden Sovereign*, thanks to its release as a Scholastic paperback in the 1960s. *Golden Sovereign* incorporates all the elements of an enduring classic: likeable characters, an elegant rescue mare with a mysterious past, and a stunning palomino stallion with enormous potential but an unpredictable disposition. Through plot twists and turns, high points and lows, this book—the third in Lyons' *Connie McGuire* series—embodies all the facets of a perennial classic.



### **The Sweet Running Filly by Barbara Van Tuyl and Pat Johnson**

This book and its sequels (collectively known as "the Bonnie books") bridge the literary gap between mysteries and horse fiction, and introduce the characters of Julie Jefferson and her "sweet running" filly, Bonnie. Originally published in the 1970s, the books achieved substantial popularity (*The Sweet Running Filly* originally sold over 200,000 copies) before going out of print. But today's fans are in luck, because the Bonnie books are in the process of being republished, and the first two titles in the series are again available in paperback.



### **Scarlet Royal by Anne Emery**

Anne Emery is most remembered for the popular teen fiction that she produced during the '50s and '60s (including such titles as *Sorority Girl*, *Going Steady*, *The Popular Crowd*, and *First Orchid for Pat*), but she also penned a well-loved horse story entitled *Scarlet Royal*. Despite the fact that horse-related fiction was not Emery's area of specialization, *Scarlet Royal* resonated with readers thanks to its realistic characters, intriguing plot device, and characteristically happy ending. While horse-savvy readers may note (and chuckle at) a few equine-related factual errors in the story, this satisfying tale deserves modern-day consideration.

So, reflect back to your childhood—what novels do you recall reading? Which ones will you seek out and discover all over again?



# Paddington Bear Statue

## Paddington Station London, England

*As if Paddington Bear wasn't famous before, he is now even more so, especially after his afternoon "Tea" with the Queen of England during her 70th Jubilee celebrations.*

*And did you know, after nearly 60 years, there's still a bear at Paddington Station looking for help!*



IN OCTOBER 1958, A FORLORN bear with a suitcase sat at London's Paddington Station, looking around as commuters walked all around him. A note attached to his coat read "Please look after this bear. Thank you." The Brown family who came across this bear took him home, and named him Paddington Bear, after the location where he was found.

The beloved bear is, of course, from the famous children's books written by Michael Bond, who based him on a lone bear he saw at a London store near Paddington station. Bond was also inspired by young evacuees leaving London during World War II with labels around their necks, and their possessions packed into small suitcases.



The Paddington Bear books tell the stories of this polite bear whose aunt in Peru sends him to England as a stowaway. He gets into all kinds of scrapes in London but always tries hard to get things right.

The series and character became a huge hit, and the books have sold over 30 million copies worldwide.

In 2014 a movie was made to celebrate this cute little bear.

After nearly 60 years since their publication, this little bear from Peru can still be found at the train station on Platform 1, looking for help.

A life-size bronze statue of Paddington Bear designed by sculptor Marcus Cornish was unveiled in February 2000. There's also a Paddington Bear store in the station, full of merchandise dedicated to one of literature's favorite furry friends.

And there is another Paddington statue, this one more than 6000 miles away, in the little bear's hometown of Lima, Peru. (see next page)

## Paddington Bear of Lima

The little bear in the "funny kind of hat" has made his way from London back to Peru.

**"PLEASE LOOK AFTER THIS BEAR"** are the words inscribed on the Paddington Bear statue that was gifted to the municipality of Miraflores, in the city of Lima, on the coast of Peru. A gift of the British Embassy, the little bear now watches over the Miraflores Boardwalk, a playground, and the Pacific Ocean.

Unveiled in July of 2015 to commemorate the strong ties between the UK and Peru (his original home in the story), this Paddington was one of 50 bears designed by artists, actors, politicians (and at least one supermodel), originally scattered all over London to create the "Paddington Trail." The designers were an eclectic bunch, running the gamut from Nicole Kidman to Rhianna, from David Beckham to Kate Moss, from Andrew Lloyd Webber to Bear Grylls. This particular one was designed by British comedian Stephen Fry.

Having made his way back to Peru, Paddington's new playground perch is located in Parque Salazar along the Miraflores Boardwalk, looking out over the Bay of Santander.

The statue's dedication was overseen by Alan Yarrow, Lord Mayor of the City of London (where there is another Paddington statue at the little bear's namesake train station), and Jorge Muñoz, Mayor of Miraflores. Paddington has been a staple bedtime story for many generations of children. Lucky little bear - now he gets to hang out with them all day.
