

Cats with green fur is not a natural color for cats. The first green cat was born in Denmark in 1995 and was named "Miss Greeny". The reason that the green color in Miss Greeny's fur was initially thought to be caused by a genetic mutation. However, a vet later attributed the color to a copper patina from the local water supply. The copper caused a verdigris effect, which normally would be toxic. Apparently, the green color faded as Miss Greeny grew new fur, likely because she was no longer exposed to the copper-rich water.

\*What is the Blarney Stone and why is it famous? Kissing Ireland's Blarney Stone is a tradition that's been around for several centuries, and is said to give a person the gift of eloquence and persuasiveness. The iconic stone is set in a wall of Blarney Castle, constructed in 1446 by Dermot McCarthy, King of Munster, on the site of a demolished 13th century castle.

# **FUN TRIVIA**



\*It is estimated that about 65-70% percent of pet owners will give St. Patrick's Day gifts/treats to their pets!

\*Known as the Emerald Isle, Ireland is the third largest island in Europe, and home to almost 5 million people. Potatoes, whiskey, along with Peter O'Toole, Liam Neeson, Pierce Brosnan and Aidan Turner are amongst its many famous movie stars.

\*The first St. Patrick's Day parade/celebration in the USA was held in Boston in 1737. NYC's St. Patrick's Day parade has been happening since 1762 and is one of the world's largest.

\*The Northern Lapwing (Vanellus vanellus) was declared the Republic of Ireland's national bird by a committee of the Irish Wildlife Conservancy in 1990. The Lapwing's colors include green white and gold which are the colors on the Irish flag.

\*Of all the cat colors in the world, albino is the rarest. Albinism causes a complete lack of pigment, so cats have pink skin, white fur, and pale blue or pink eyes. In order to be albino, a cat must inherit two recessive genes for albinism (A/A), one from each parent. Albino dogs can also occur in any breed, but are more common in some breeds, such as Doberman Pinschers, Pugs, Pekingese, Lhasa Apsos, Pomeranians, and Dachshunds.

\*Saint Brigid, also known as Brigid of Kildare, is Ireland's only female patron saint. She was born around the year 451 AD, just north of Dundalk, County Louth. During her life, she was an early Irish Christian nun, abbess and founder of many different monasteries of nuns.



# The White House has a twin in Ireland

Many people know that the White House was designed by an Irishman, Mr. James Hoban, but not everybody knows that the White House building has an Irish twin.

Kilkenny-born Hoban, who studied architecture in Dublin, is believed to have based his plan for the U.S. presidential home on Ireland's Leinster House, the Georgian style home of the Dukes of Leinster that is now home of the Dail Éireann (Irish Parliament).











# **Irish Domestic Cats**

enduring popularity of Ireland were in cats SO beloved that in the Middle Ages, a set of laws known Catslechtae described as penalties associated with mistreating these feline friends. Today, there are approximately 325,000 cats keeping households company throughout Ireland.

Irish Domestic cats are not pedigreed cats. Rather, they are random-bred cats that have developed in Ireland and adapted to their native environment. Despite lacking purebred status, some cat associations allow them to compete in shows in a general "housecat" category.

The Manx and Cymric are cat breeds with Irish roots. The Manx is a tailless cat that originated on the Isle of Man, which is located in the Irish Sea. The Cymric is a long-haired version of the Manx.

### So Irish . . . !

\*The ancient Irish Alphabet was called the Ogham and was used from the 5th to 10th centuries.

\*The worldwide spread of St. Patrick's Day was partially due to the 1845-1849 Great Potato Famine that forced more than a million Irish to emigrate. Today, more than 200 countries celebrate it.

\*The phrase "Kiss me, I'm Irish" quote comes from the Blarney Stone legend, which is supposed to bring luck to you if you kiss it.

\*Because corned beef and cabbage is an Irish American creation and tradition, what do people in Ireland typically eat on St. Patrick's Day? They eat Irish Fry, scones, Irish soda bread, beef pot roast and more as these are traditional Irish meals on St. Patrick's Day.

\*Back in the 1800's, the term "Paddy Wagon" comes from when the drunk Irish got arrested and they all said their name was Paddy (i.e. like John Doe today).

### SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

### Arroyo Burro Beach Park

Located at 2981 Cliff Drive, this county park is the portal for the best known off-leash spot in the Santa Barbara area. Dogs are required to be on leash through the parking lot and bathing beach until, passing Arroyo Burro Slough, dogs are welcome to run free and cavort in the Pacific Ocean surf below the city's Douglas Family Preserve. Self service dog wash stations provided by County Parks.

Hours: Daily from 8:00am - Dusk

### TUCKERS GROVE PARK

Newly fenced off-leash area at Kiwanis Meadow is now open. The new play area is at the eastern end of the park, and is near ample parking and a public restroom. This area also provides easy access to the San Antonio Creek Trail, a mostly shaded 1.5-mile route that heads northeasterly to a trailhead at CA Route 154. Tucker's Grove County Park is located at intersection of Turnpike and Cathedral Oaks Roads.

# THE IRISH SETTER



The Irish Red Setter, originating in Ireland, is believed to have developed from a mix of English Setters, Spaniels, Pointers, and Gordon Setters, with early ancestors being predominantly red and white in color; through selective breeding, the solid red coat became the defining characteristic of the breed, making the "Irish Red Setter" the modern standard today.

Key points about the Irish Red Setter history:

### **Early Setters in Ireland:**

Setting dogs existed in Ireland since the 1700s, primarily used to locate game birds by "setting" or freezing in place when they found scent, allowing hunters to approach and capture the prey with nets.

### **Color Variation:**

The original Irish Setters were not solid red, but rather a mix of red and white markings, with breeders eventually selecting for the solid red color.



# **19th Century Development:**

The solid red Irish Setter as we know it today became established in the 19th century, gaining popularity in both hunting and show rings due to its striking red coat.

Irish Setters were brought to the United States in the late 1800s, where they further gained popularity as both working hunting dogs and show dogs.

# **Decline and Revival:**

During the mid-20th century, the breed's focus shifted more towards onformation in show rings, potentially impacting their working abilities. Modern breeders are working to re-emphasize the Irish Setter's hunting instincts while maintaining their elegant appearance.
